Sabalenka:

- The two-time defending champion returns for her ninth main draw appearance at the US Open, having reached the final in each of her last three visits
- She won back-to-back titles in 2024 (d. Pegula in F) and 2025 (d. Anisimova in F), after finishing runner-up in 2023 (l. Gauff in F)
- Last year she became the first woman to win consecutive US Open singles titles since Serena Williams from 2012-2014
- Contesting her 34th career Grand Slam main draw; along with her two US Open titles, she also won back-to-back Australian Open titles in 2023 (d. Rybakina in F) and 2024 (d. Zheng Qinwen in F)
- Has won her last 23 consecutive Grand Slam 1r matches, last losing to Suarez Navarro at 2020 Australian Open



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- At Grand Slams this year, as well as her runner-up finish at Australian Open (I. Rybakina in F), she made QF at Roland Garros (I. Shnaider) and R16 at Wimbledon (I. Osaka)
- Sabalenka is one of only two players on Tour to have won three titles this season (Brisbane, Indian Wells, Miami), alongside M. Andrejeva (Adelaide, Linz, Roland Garros)
- Owns a 27-3 record on hard court this season, with her 27 wins ranking third on Tour behind Rybakina and Pegula (29 each)
- So far during this year's North American hard court swing, made R16 at Toronto (I. Alexandrova) and Cincinnati (I. Bejlek)
- 21 of her 24 career WTA titles have come on hard court, including her three titles this year at Brisbane (d. Kostyuk in F), Indian Wells (d. Rybakina in F) and Miami (d. Gauff in F)
- Sabalenka has held the No.1 ranking since October 21, 2024. Including the upcoming weeks at the US Open, she will hold the No.1 ranking for 99 consecutive weeks, bringing her career total to 107 weeks atop the Rankings
- Sabalenka must win the title in order to have a chance of retaining the No.1 ranking after the US Open

Osorio:

- Making 6th appearance at US Open, where her best result was reaching 2r in 2022 (I. Riske-Amritraj) and 2021 (I. Jabeur)
- Contesting her 23rd career Grand Slam main draw overall – she has an 11-11 record in Grand Slam 1r matches (2-3 in US Open 1r matches, including 1r losses in each of the last three years here)
- Her career-best results across all Grand Slams are 3r finishes at 2021 Wimbledon (I. today's opponent Sabalenka) and 2026 Roland Garros (I. Kalinskaya)
- Looking to earn a win over World No.1 for first time in her career (I. then-No.1 Swiatek at Australian Open 2023)
- Owns two Top 10 wins in her career, most recently over No.4 Garcia at 2023 Rome (this is her first meeting vs. a Top 10 player in 2026)
- Career-best Tour-level results on hard court are Runner-Up finishes at Monterrey in 2022 (I. Fernandez in F) and Tenerife in 2021 (I. Li in F)
- So far during this year's North American hard court swing, reached 2r at Memphis (I. Zakharova), 2r at Toronto (I. Alexandrova), and 1r at both Cincinnati (I. Townsend) and Monterrey (I. Li)
- Best Tour-level result of 2026 season so far is QF run at Rabat on clay (I. eventual R-Up Udvardy)
- Owns 3 career WTA titles, all at Bogota on clay: in 2025 (d. Kawa in F), 2024 (d. Bouzkova in F) and 2021 (d. Zidansek in F)
- Reached career-high ranking of No.33 in April 2022

Volynets:

- Looking for her first US Open main draw match-win after falling in the 1r in all of her five previous main draw appearances
- Reached her best Grand Slam result in 2023 by making 3r at Australian Open as a qualifier (d. No.9 V.Kudermetova in 2r for her first career Top 10 win; l. Zhang Shuai)
- Owens two career Top 10 wins, defeating No.9 V.Kudermetova at 2023 Australian Open and No.6 Jabeur at 2024 Indian Wells (0-3 vs. Top 10 players since then – Volynets won the first set in all three of these matches)
- Enters US Open having won last week's WTA 125 title in Philadelphia on hard court (d. Valentova in final)
- Earlier this year at WTA 125-level, she reached the final at Newport in June on grass (l. Maria in final)
- Her best WTA Tour-level results of 2026 have come on hard court with SF at Ostrava (l. eventual champion Boulter) and QF at Memphis (l. eventual runner-up Vidmanova)
- Her most recent WTA Tour-level meeting vs. a Czech player was her 2026 Memphis loss to Vidmanova; she also played and defeated another Czech, Tereza Valentova, in the WTA 125 Philadelphia final last week
- Reached a career-high ranking of No.56 in July 2024



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Noskova:

- Making her 5th appearance at the US Open; her best performance at the tournament is reaching the 3rd round last year (l. Muchova)
- Won her first career Grand Slam title earlier this summer at Wimbledon (d. Muchova in all-Czech final), becoming the youngest Wimbledon champion since her fellow Czech Petra Kvitova in 2011
- She is 9-2 at Grand Slam events this year – this is already her most Grand Slam match-wins in a calendar year (previous best was 6 Grand Slam main draw match-wins in 2024)
- Her best result at a hard court Grand Slam is quarterfinals at 2024 Australian Open (l. Yastremska)
- Has won two titles this year, both on grass at Berlin (d. Pegula in final) and Wimbledon
- Holds an 11-8 record on hard court this year, with her best hard-court result in 2026 being Indian Wells SF (l. eventual champion Sabalenka)
- Has a 9-7 career record in Grand Slam 1r matches (2-2 in US Open 1r matches)
- Her two most recent losses have been to Americans, at 2026 Toronto (l. McNally in 2r) and 2026 Cincinnati (l. Anisimova in 4r)
- Made her Top 10 debut in the PIF WTA Rankings on June 22 of this year (following her 2026 Berlin title), and reached career-high ranking of No.6 on August 24

Kraus:

- Making her US Open main draw debut, and her 3rd Grand Slam main draw appearance of career (l. Selekhmeteva in 1r at Wimbledon 2026, l. No.11 Bencic in 1r at Roland Garros 2026)
- Best career Tour-level results are Round of 16 appearances at Auckland (2026), Hamburg (2025, 2026) and Bogota (2023)
- Her lone career Tour-level victory on hard court came earlier this year in 1r at Auckland (d. fellow Austrian Grabher)
- This is her first career match at a Tour-level event against a Top 10 opponent (Kraus previously faced and lost to No.3 Pegula in 2023 Billie Jean King Cup)
- Highest-ranked player she has defeated in her Tour-level career is No.92 Grabher at Auckland
- Seeking her first career Tour-level win over an opponent from Czech Republic (0-3 in previous opportunities)
- One of four players from Austria in the main draw, joining Julia Grabher, Anastasia Potapova and Lilli Tagger
- Has won two Tour-level matches so far in 2026 (d. Semenistaja at Hamburg, d. Grabher at Auckland)
- Claimed one WTA 125 title in 2026, last month on clay at Kitzbuhel (d. Grabher in all-Austrian final on home soil)
- Reached a career-high ranking of No.80 this year (July 20)



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Muchova:

- Making her 9th main draw appearance at the US Open (29th Grand Slam main draw appearance)
- She is a two-time US Open semifinalist in 2023 (l. eventual champion Gauff) and 2024 (l. eventual runner-up Pegula), and also reached quarterfinals last year (l. Osaka)
- She is a two-time Grand Slam runner-up at 2023 Roland Garros (l. Swiatek in final) and 2026 Wimbledon (l. Noskova in all-Czech final)
- Won the 2026 US Open mixed doubles title last week (w/fellow Czech Mensik, d. Bencic/Cobolli in final) – her first Grand Slam title in any discipline
- Has won two WTA titles this year at WTA 1000 Doha on hard court (her first WTA 1000 title, d. Mboko in final) and Bad Homburg on grass (d. Osaka in final via retirement)
- Reached two additional finals this year at Stuttgart (l. Rybakina in final) and Wimbledon (l. Noskova in final)
- Holds an 18-4 record on hard court in 2026 – she has only lost to Top 5 players on hard court this year
- This is her first hard court event since Miami in March (made SF, l. eventual R-Up Gauff), and her first event overall since 2026 Wimbledon
- Has a 19-9 career record in Grand Slam 1r matches (6-2 in US Open 1r matches)
- First career Tour-level match against a player from Austria
- Holds a Tour-level record of 17-1 in 2026 against opponents ranked outside the Top 50 (l. No.170 Teichmann in 3r at Roland Garros)
- In Grand Slam main draws, she is 32-9 versus players ranked outside the Top 50, and 13-0 in such matches in US Open main draws
- Has won 35 Tour-level matches so far in 2026 (18 on hard court). With a win, would equal her career-best for Tour-level match wins in a single season (36 in 2023)
- Posted career-high ranking of No.6 following her run to this year's Wimbledon final

Swiatek:

- Making her 8th appearance at the US Open, where she won the title in 2022 (d. Jabeur in final)
- She has also reached the US Open quarterfinals in each of the last two years, losing to eventual runner-up Pegula in 2024 and to eventual runner-up Anisimova in 2025
- Has won six Grand Slam titles in her career, including four Roland Garros titles (2020, 2022, 2023 and 2024) and the Wimbledon title in 2025 – she is 6-0 in Grand Slam finals
- Among active players, only Serena Williams (23) and Venus Williams (7) have claimed more Grand Slam titles than Swiatek (6)
- Won her first title of 2026 earlier this month at WTA 1000 Toronto on hard court (d. Rybakina in final) – this is the sixth straight year she has won at least one WTA 1000 title
- Has won 10 of her last 11 hard court matches, following up her 2026 Toronto title with a semifinal run at 2026 Cincinnati (l. eventual runner-up Pegula)
- Holds a 29-1 career record in Grand Slam 1r matches – her only 1r loss at a Grand Slam event was to Viktorija Golubic at 2019 Wimbledon
- Owns 15-1 record this season against opponents ranked outside the Top 50, with sole loss coming against No.52 Sakkari at Doha
- Reached World No.1 for the first time on April 4, 2022, and held the top ranking for 125 weeks during her career



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Wang:

- Making her 6th appearance at US Open, where her best result is reaching R32 in 2022 (l. Riske-Amritraj)
- Overall, is making her 17th appearance across all the Slams; best result is reaching R16 at Roland Garros 2026 as a qualifier (l. Cirstea)
- Career record in 1r matches at Grand Slams is 6-10 (2-3 at US Open)
- Record against Top 10 opponents is 1-9, having defeated No.3 Sakkari here at US Open 2022
- Her sole career singles title has come on hard court at Guangzhou 2023 (d. Linette in F); reached another final on hard court at Austin 2024 (l. compatriot Yuan in F)
- In her last two events, made R16 run at Cincinnati (as qualifier, l. Keys - her second career R16 at WTA 1000 events, after Rome 2023), then made WTA 125 Philadelphia QF before withdrawing from that match
- Reached a career-high ranking of No.49 in January 2023

Krueger:

- Making her 6th US Open appearance of career; her best tournament showing was in 2024 when she reached 3r (I. Samsonova)
- This is her 15th career Grand Slam main draw, and her best Grand Slam result was achieved this year at Wimbledon with 4r (as qualifier, I. Kostyuk)
- She has reached two Tour-level finals in her career (both on hard court), winning the title at 2023 Osaka (d. Zhu Lin in F) and finishing runner-up at 2025 Abu Dhabi (I. Bencic in F)
- Owns 1-12 career record against Top 10 players, with her one Top 10 win coming over No.8 Rybakina at 2025 Miami (0-2 vs. Top 10 players in 2026)
- Holds a 6-8 record in Grand Slam 1r matches (2-3 in US Open 1r matches, with victories in her last two US Open 1r matches)
- Has an 8-14 career Tour-level record against her fellow American players (2-4 in 2026)
- Reached a career high ranking of No.29 in July of last year



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Anisimova:

- Making her 7th main draw appearance at the US Open, where her best tournament result is finishing runner-up last year (I. Sabalenka in final)
- She made two Grand Slam finals in 2025, also finishing runner-up at Wimbledon last year (I. Swiatek in final)
- Her best tournament finish so far this year is semifinals at WTA 1000 Dubai (I. eventual champion Pegula)
- 15 of her 20 Tour-level match-wins this year have come on hard court, including the Dubai semifinals, as well as quarterfinal results at Australian Open and WTA 1000 Cincinnati (I. Pegula in both of those quarterfinals)
- Three of her 4 career WTA titles have been achieved on hard court, including two WTA 1000 titles at 2025 Doha (d. Ostapenko in final) and 2025 Beijing (d. Noskova in final)
- Owns 18-8 career record in Grand Slam 1r matches; her most recent Grand Slam 1r loss was to Zheng Qinwen at the 2024 US Open
- Holds a 24-22 career Tour-level record against her fellow American players (2-5 in 2026)
- Reached her career-high ranking of No.3 on January 5 of this year
- Competed in 2026 US Open mixed doubles event last week (w/Tien, I. Navarro/Paul in 1r)
- Celebrating her 25th birthday today, Monday, August 31

Osaka:

- The two-time US Open champion returns to make her 10th main draw appearance at the event, having won titles here in 2020 (d. Azarenka in F) and 2018 (d. S. Williams in F)
- At last year's US Open, reached her first Grand Slam SF since winning 2021 Australian Open (l. eventual runner-up Anisimova in 2025 US Open SF)
- Contesting her 35th Grand Slam main draw; in addition to her two US Open titles, she owns two Australian Open trophies, winning in 2019 (d. Kvitova in F) and 2021 (d. Brady in F)
- Owns 28-6 career record in Grand Slam 1r matches (8-1 in US Open 1r matches, with her only US Open 1r exit coming against Collins in 2022)
- At the Grand Slams this season, reached R32 at Australian Open (walkover vs. qualifier Inglis), her first career R16 at Roland Garros (l. Sabalenka), and her maiden Wimbledon QF (l. eventual runner-up Muchova)
- She is 9-2 at the Grand Slams this year – if she wins today, she would claim 10 Grand Slam match-wins in a calendar year for the first time since claiming 12 in 2019 (she had 9 Slam match-wins in 2020, 2021 and 2025)
- Reached her 14th career Tour-level singles final earlier this season at Bad Homburg on grass (l. Muchova via ret. In F) – this was also her first WTA Tour-level final not contested on hard court
- All seven of her Tour-level titles have come on hard court; in addition to her 4 Grand Slam titles, she won Indian Wells in 2018, and Beijing and Osaka in 2019



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- Owns a 10-5 record on hard court this season, highlighted by SF finish at Washington DC (l. eventual champion Eala) and QF at Toronto (l. eventual R-Up Rybakina)
- Reached World No.1 for the first time on January 28, 2019, and held the top ranking for 25 weeks in her career

Zakharova:

- Making her 2nd main draw appearance at the US Open; she reached the 2nd round last year (d. Avanesyan in 1r; l. Siegemund)
- She had previously lost in US Open qualifying in 2022 (l. Noskova) and 2024 (l. Gibson)
- This is her 7th career Grand Slam main draw appearance; her best Grand Slam result is 3rd round at 2024 Australian Open (as qualifier, l. Frech), which was also her Grand Slam main draw debut
- Seeking first Grand Slam win of the year – she is 0-3 in Grand Slam 1r matches in 2026, each of those losses to Top 10 players (l. Pegula at 2026 Australian Open; l. Muchova at both 2026 Roland Garros and 2026 Wimbledon)
- Spanning all tournament levels, she is 0-7 vs. Top 20 players in her career (0-14 in sets), with six of those losses occurring in 2026
- Her best Tour-level finish this year is reaching Memphis quarterfinals on hard court last month (l. Zarazua)
- Eight of her 10 Tour-level match-wins this year have been on hard court, including Memphis quarterfinals and 3rd round finish at WTA 1000 Miami as a qualifier (l. Mboko)
- Owns 2-0 career Tour-level record against players from Japan (d. Shibahara at 2025 Jiujiang; d. Uchijima at 2026 Dubai)
- Reached career-high ranking of No.65 on April 6 of this year

Chwalinska:

- Making her US Open main draw debut this year – she contested qualifying here in 2022, 2024 and 2025 but did not advance to the main draw on any of those occasions
