ANDREEVA QUICK HITS:

- This is her second career Grand Slam mixed doubles event after making QF here at US Open last year (w/Medvedev; d. Danilovic/Djokovic in 1r, I. Pegula/Draper in QF)
- Contested mixed doubles at the 2024 Paris Olympics alongside Medvedev (I. Errani/Vavassori in 1r)
- Her best women's doubles results at a Grand Slam are SFs at 2025 Roland Garros (w/Shnaider; I. eventual champions Errani/Paolini) and 2025 Australian Open (w/Shnaider; I. eventual champions Siniakova/Townsend); also made QF at 2024 Roland Garros (w/Zvonareva; I. Kostyuk/Ruse)
- Owns 3 WTA doubles titles, all with Shnaider (Rome in 2026 and Miami & Brisbane in 2025) and the pairing also won women's doubles silver medal at the 2024 Paris Olympics
- In singles, she owns six career titles, including three this season at Adelaide, Linz and her maiden Grand Slam at Roland Garros, where she became the youngest champion since Seles in 1992



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RUBLEV QUICK HITS:

- Plays in his second Grand Slam mixed doubles main draw after losing in 2R of US Open last year w/Muchova to eventual champions Errani/Vavassori.
- Captured gold medal at 2021 Tokyo Olympics in mixed doubles (w/Pavlyuchenkova), earning 13-11 deciding set wins over Barty/Peers in SF and Karatsev/Vesnina in final.
- Made 5 men's doubles Grand Slam appearances, last at 2020 Australian Open (w/Vasilevski), and earned best result by reaching 2017 US Open 3R (w/Khachanov).
- Won 4 ATP Tour titles in doubles: at 2015 Moscow (w/Tursunov), 2021 Doha (w/Karatsev), 2022 Marseille (w/Molchanov) and 2023 ATP Masters 1000 Madrid (w/Khachanov).
- In singles, advanced to 10 Grand Slam quarter-finals, most recent at 2024 Australian Open, but still seeks 1st SF.
- 18-time ATP Tour champion, including ATP Masters 1000 titles at 2023 Monte-Carlo and 2024 Madrid.
- This year, won Bastad title, reached Barcelona final and advanced to Australian Open 3R and Roland Garros 4R before 1R loss in Wimbledon (27-16 in 2026).

ANISIMOVA QUICK HITS:

- Fell 1r in last year's US Open mixed doubles event (w/Rune, I. Townsend/Shelton)
- Notched first mixed doubles match-win at 2020 Australian Open w/ Nick Kyrgios (l. 2r to eventual champions Krejcikova/Mektic); also posted 1r mixed doubles losses in 2017 and 2018 at the US Open
- Owns 2 career Tour-level match-wins in women's doubles, both at Roland Garros (reached 2r at 2019 Roland Garros w/Knoll and 2021 Roland Garros w/Potapova)
- In singles, reached back-to-back Grand Slam finals last year at Wimbledon (l. Swiatek in F) and US Open (l. Sabalenka in F); reached career-high ranking of No.3 at the beginning of this year



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TIEN QUICK HITS:

- Plays in his second Grand Slam mixed doubles main draw after losing in 1R of 2024 US Open w/Ngounoue.
- Played in three Grand Slam men's doubles draws after 2025 Roland Garros w/Seggerman, reaching 2R, before 1R losses at 2025 Wimbledon (w/Kovacevic) and 2025 US Open (w/Giron).
- He is the youngest man in the field (age 20) and will make his fifth singles main draw appearance at US Open next week, first debuting in 2022, and still looks for first win in singles or doubles at this event.
- In juniors, won boys' doubles at 2023 Australian Open w/C. Williams, defeating Blockx/Fonseca in final and advanced to 2023 US Open boys' singles final, losing to Fonseca.
- This year, reached 1st Grand Slam quarter-final at Australian Open (d. No. 12 Medvedev in 4R), won his second ATP Tour title in Geneva, and reached 1st ATP Masters 1000 SF in Montreal earlier this month.

BENCIC QUICK HITS:

- Fell 1r in last year's US Open mixed doubles event (w/Zverev, I. Collins/Harrison)
- At other Grand Slam mixed doubles events, her best results are R16s at 2014 Wimbledon (w/Martin Klizan) and 2021 US Open (w/Filip Polasek)
- Partnering Jakub Paul, went 4-1 in mixed doubles at the 2026 United Cup during Team Switzerland's run to the final (holds a 6-2 career mixed doubles record at United Cup)
- Has won two WTA doubles titles, both in 2015 at Prague (w/Siniakova) and Washington DC (w/Mladenovic)
- Earned the silver medal in women's doubles at the 2021 Olympics for Switzerland (w/Golubic; I. in gold medal final to Krejcikova/Siniakova)
- Also won gold medal in women's singles at 2021 Tokyo Olympics (d. Vondrousova in gold medal match)



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COBOLLI QUICK HITS:

- Making his Grand Slam mixed doubles debut and previously went 0-1 at 2024 United Cup (w/Brancaccio).
- Earlier this season, played in Indian Wells mixed doubles exhibition (w/Bencic), defeating two-time US Open champions Errani/Vavassori in SF and Dabrowski/Glasspool in final to win the title.
- Earned best men's doubles result by reaching the semi-finals at 2026 Halle (w/Shelton) and owns 1-5 career record in Grand Slam men's doubles, reaching 2R at 2024 US Open (w/Stricker).
- This year, advanced to Roland Garros final, becoming the third Grand Slam men's finalist born in 2000s, joining Sinner (2001) and Alcaraz (2003).
- Also reached Wimbledon quarter-finals, won Acapulco title, and advanced to finals of Munich and made his Top 10 debut, achieving career-high No. 6 on Monday.

EALA QUICK HITS:

- Contesting the first mixed doubles event of her career
- Has competed in four Grand Slam women's doubles draws in her career, reaching the 2r once, at 2025 Roland Garros (w/Zarazua; d. Appleton/Cavalle-Reimers in 1r, l. Danilovic/Potapova in 2r)
- On her three most recent Grand Slam doubles appearances, she has fallen in the 1r: 2026 Wimbledon (w/Bartunkova; l. Kenin/Ostapenko), 2026 Australian Open (w/Martins; l. Aoyama/Linette) and 2025 Wimbledon (w/Lys; l. Martins/Gleason)
- Her best career doubles results are semifinal showings at 2026 Abu Dhabi (w/Tjen), 2026 Auckland (w/Jovic) and 2025 Guangzhou (w/N.Kichenok)
- In singles, she won her maiden Tour-level title during this year's US swing at Washington DC (d. Pegula in F), which saw her break into the Top 20 for the first time in her career



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AUGER-ALIASSIME QUICK HITS:

- Making his Grand Slam mixed doubles debut and second Grand Slam doubles appearance after losing in 1R of men's doubles at 2021 Australian Open (w/Hurkacz).
- Earned bronze medal in mixed doubles at 2024 Paris Olympics (w/Dabrowski) after loss in 2021 Tokyo Olympics 1R.
- He is 2-2 at United Cup in mixed doubles, going 0-1 w/Fung in 2024, 1-1 w/Fernandez in 2025 and 1-0 w/Mboko earlier this season.
- Won 1 ATP Tour doubles title at 2020 ATP Masters 1000 Paris and advanced to final of 2021 Halle (both w/Hurkacz).
- Played in two doubles tournaments this season, reaching 2R of Indian Wells (w/Korda) and 's-Hertogenbosch (w/Shapovalov).
- Six-time Grand Slam singles quarter-finalist, including runs to SFs at US Open in 2021 and last year.
- This season, won Montpellier title and advanced to Grand Slam quarter-finals of Roland Garros and Wimbledon.

ERRANI QUICK HITS:

- Owns four Grand Slam mixed doubles titles (all w/Vavassori) – winning 2026 Roland Garros (d. Dabrowski/King in F), 2025 US Open (d. Swiatek/Ruud in F), 2025 Roland Garros (d. Townsend/King in F) and 2024 US Open (d. Townsend/Young in F)
- Has won 36 career women's doubles titles, including six Grand Slam titles: 2025 Roland Garros (w/Paolini), 2014 Wimbledon (w/Peng), 2014-2013 Australian Open (both w/Vinci), 2012 US Open (w/Vinci) and 2012 Roland Garros (w/Vinci)
- She is an Olympics gold medalist, winning the women's doubles title at Paris 2024 (w/ Paolini)
- Reached the World No.1 doubles ranking on Sept. 10, 2012, spending a total of 87 weeks at the top
- In singles she owns nine Tour-level titles, most recently 2016 Dubai; she is also a Grand Slam singles finalist, finishing runner-up at 2012 Roland Garros (l. Sharapova in F)



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VAVASSORI QUICK HITS:

- Four-time mixed doubles Grand Slam champion (2024 & 2025 US Open, 2025 & 2026 Roland Garros), all w/Errani, aiming to become the first team to three-peat US Open mixed doubles since Osborne duPont/Fraser in 1958-60.
- Three-time Grand Slam men's doubles finalist, all w/Bolelli, at 2024 Australian Open, 2024 Roland Garros and 2025 Australian Open.
- 13-time ATP Tour doubles champion, winning 3 titles this year, in Rotterdam before 1st ATP Masters 1000 titles of career in Miami and Rome, both w/Bolelli, becoming 1st all-Italian team to win Rome men's doubles in Open Era.
- This year in mixed doubles, also teamed up with Errani at Australian Open (1R) and Wimbledon (2R) and went 1-1 at United Cup, as Team Italy was eliminated in Group Stage.
- In singles, peaked at No. 128 in 2023, advanced to ATP Tour QFs at 2023 Marrakech and 2024 Buenos Aires and advanced to 2R of 2023 Roland Garros (d. Kecmanovic) and 2024 Paris Olympics (d. Martinez).

- Contesting her fifth career Grand Slam mixed doubles event; her best results are QF runs at 2026 Wimbledon (w/Salisbury; l. Zhang/ Harrison) and 2022 US Open (w/Sock; l. Hunter/Peers)
- Best women's doubles Grand Slam result is runner-up at 2023 Roland Garros (w/Townsend; l. Hsieh/Wang); also made 2023 US Open QF (w/Townsend; l. eventual champions Dabrowski/Routliffe)
- Has reached five Tour-level doubles finals: 2026 London (w/Siegemund), 2024 Cincinnati (w/Putintseva), 2023 Roland Garros, 2023 Miami (both w/Townsend) and 2023 Auckland (w/Mattek-Sands)
- In singles, owns five Tour-level titles: Osaka and Washington DC in 2025, Hong Kong in 2023, Monterrey in 2022-2021; also reached the final at 2021 US Open as a teenager (l. Raducanu in F)
- Owns a career-high singles ranking of No.13 (achieved in August 2022)



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TIAFOE QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his sixth Grand Slam mixed doubles draw, highlighted by advancing to 2R at 2015 US Open (w/Vickery) and 2019 Wimbledon (w/V. Williams).
- Also played US Open mixed doubles in 2016 (w/Vickery), 2018 (w/Osuigwe) and last year (w/Keys).
- Earned most recent mixed doubles win at 2023 United Cup, teaming up with Pegula to defeat Siegemund/Altmaier.
- Reached 1 ATP Tour doubles final at 2017 Houston w/D. Brown and recorded best Grand Slam men's doubles result by advancing to 3R of 2021 Australian Open (w/Monroe).
- At US Open, advanced to 3R in men's singles every year since 2020, reaching 2022 and 2024 SFs and 2023 QF, highlighted by win over No. 3 Nadal in 2022 en route to becoming 1st American men's US Open semi-finalist since 2006.
- Owns 4 career titles, at 2018 Delray Beach, 2023 Houston, 2023 Stuttgart and 2026 Halle.
- This year, owns third-most singles wins on ATP Tour (37), behind Zverev (46) and Sinner (44), highlighted by winning his biggest title of career in Halle and advancing to ATP Masters 1000 Cincinnati final.

- Also played mixed doubles with the Czech team at the 2025 United Cup alongside Machac, going 1-1 in the group stages (d. Norway's Eikeri/Duras; l. Poland's Swiatek/Hurkacz)
- Competed in women's doubles at three Grand Slam, reaching the 2r once at 2019 US Open (w/Teichmann; l. eventual champions Mertens/Sabalenka in 2r)
- On her two other Grand Slam doubles appearances, she fell in the 1r: 2020 Australian Open (w/Teichmann; l. Gauff/McNally) and 2019 Roland Garros 2026 (w/Golubic; l. Atawo/Srebotnik)
- Best WTA doubles results are SFs at 2025 Beijing (w/Hon) and 2024 Paris Olympics (w/Noskova)

- Making his mixed doubles debut and plays in his second Grand Slam doubles draw after partnering with countryman Machac at 2025 Wimbledon, losing to Martinez/Munar in 1R.
- Advanced to 1 ATP Tour doubles final at 2025 Brisbane (w/Lehecka).
- Played Grand Slam doubles in juniors, highlighted by run to SF at 2022 Wimbledon boys' doubles (w/Pieczkowski).
- Made his Grand Slam singles debut at US Open in 2023 at age 17 after qualifying, before becoming then-youngest man to reach Grand Slam 3R since Nadal at 2004 Aus. Open, losing to Fritz on his 18th birthday.
- Second-youngest man in the mixed doubles field after Tien (also 20 years old).
- This year, advanced to his 1st Grand Slam semi-final at Roland Garros, earned biggest win of career over No. 2 Sinner in Doha, and won his 2nd ATP Tour title in Auckland.

- Contesting the first mixed doubles event of her career
- She has competed in eight Grand Slam women's doubles main draws in her career, with her best result being a quarterfinal run at 2024 Roland Garros (w/Shnaider; l. eventual runners-up Errani/Paolini)
- Her most recent Grand Slam women's doubles appearance was at 2024 Wimbledon where she made 2r (w/Parry; d. Bronzetti/Gracheva in 1r, l. Dolehide/Krawczyk in 2r); also in 2024 made R16 in women's doubles at Australian Open (w/Shnaider; l. Krejcikova/Siegemund)
- Best career doubles results are quarterfinals at 2024 Roland Garros (w/Shnaider), 2021 Charleston (w/Dolehide) and 2019 Charleston (w/Beck)
- In singles, she owns three WTA titles, including one this year at Strasbourg (d. Mboko in F); she is also a Grand Slam singles semifinalist, at 2024 US Open (l. eventual champion Sabalenka)
- Broke into the WTA Top 10 for the first time in September 2024 following her US Open semifinal run



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PAUL QUICK HITS:

- Making his mixed doubles debut and plays in his first Grand Slam doubles draw since 2022 Wimbledon men's doubles (w/Monroe).
- Also partnering Monroe, ousted No. 4 seeds Kubot/Melo en route to 2020 Roland Garros men's doubles QF.
- Earned bronze medal at 2024 Paris Olympics men's doubles (w/Fritz), ending Andy Murray's career in QF, and advanced to two other ATP Tour doubles SFs at 2021 Delray Beach (w/McDonald) and 2022 Queen's (w/Fritz).
